Le Rire Médecin was born in 1991 when **Caroline Simonds**, an American-born Francophile and clown artist herself, decided to move to France and create the **first ever hospital clowning nonprofit** in the country. We have been operating for **almost 35 years** now- and thriving! We first started with mainly government funding and only a few clowns in two hospitals- we now raise over **6M EUR** a year, mainly from private individuals, and perform in **20 hospitals** thanks to a team of more than **150 clowns**!





We believe a happy child is easier to treat. Making the hospital a joyful place is quite a challenge, but according to general feedback, we live up to the expectation! Thus, our work helps on several levels: - children feel less distress and anxiety

and better respond to treatments,
families are supported,
medical staff benefit from a less stressful work environment- and can also enjoy a joke now and again!

This altogether benefits hospitals and the public: experience shows children wo received clown visits stay in hospital for shorter periods, and allow for a higher turnover of patients, making **treatment available to more people**.



We have a pool of 150 clowns who take turns performing in hospital. We are there all year long, at least 2 days a week. This allows us to develop close relationships with children who need to stay in hospital for a long time, possibly for a chronic disease. It has happened that we witnessed a child turn into a teenager and our clowns became role models for them! One former patient even became a stand-up artist- something we are fairly proud of!



While there little is scientific research on the benefits of hospital clowning, we know for a fact our work is paramount. Parents, children, doctors and nurses who have met our clowns can testify of the good they have brought with them and the joy they spread. What we do is not about numbers and graphs, it's about compassion and the general good.

Our President, **Dr Dominique Valteau-Couanet**, is a paediatric oncologist. She headed Gustave Roussy Institute's Department of Child and Adolescent Oncology from 2008 to 2021. She continues to work as a surgeon and conduct research into neuroblastoma, a speciality for which she is internationally renowned. In 2011, Dominique Valteau-Couanet founded Gustave Roussy's Ethics Committee, which she chaired for 3 years.

Ten **administrators** now sit at our Board, among whom two nurses. 6 **goodwill ambassadors**, most of them well-known French actors, help make our work known. 17 staff at HQ help the clowns navigate the activity and implement the Board's project. We need to secure our funding **year after year**, so we don't ever need to leave the children. We are proud to have never, in over 30 years, had to close a programme. We currently need **6.5 million EUR** p/a to keep up our work.

We would also love to be able to cater for the **17 pending requests** from children's hospitals we have received, which we cannot accommodate for the moment... Each new programme costs **130K€**.
